

The Proclamation of Separation — “I Am Leaving Babylon”

Core Teaching

Before a disciple can walk in alignment with the Kingdom, there must be a clear and intentional separation from Babylon. This separation is not symbolic or optional. It is a required beginning.

Many attempt to add Kingdom principles onto a life still rooted in the systems of Babylon. This produces mixture. Mixture produces weakness. As a result, there is no authority, no clarity, and no consistent spiritual fruit.

The ancient path cannot be walked while still drawing sustenance from systems that oppose the rule of Yah. A divided life cannot produce a submitted life.

Separation, therefore, is not about emotion or preference. It is a legal and spiritual positioning. It is a declaration of allegiance. When a disciple separates, they are choosing a new authority, a new source, and a new way of living.

This is the beginning of alignment.

Key Scriptures

- Revelation 18:4

“Come out of her, my people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues.”

- Joshua 24:15

“Choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve...”

Practical Application

Begin by establishing separation through deliberate action. Do not treat this as a feeling. Treat it as a decision that must be enforced.

Speak the proclamation of separation daily. This trains both your spirit and your mind to come into agreement with your decision.

Examine your life honestly and identify areas where Babylon still has influence. These may include religious systems that distort truth, habits that oppose discipline, or dependencies that replace trust in Yah.

Write down at least three areas where you remain connected to these systems. Do not justify them. Do not ignore them. Identify them clearly so they can be addressed.

Separation begins with awareness, but it must move into action.

Proclamation or Exercise

Declare daily:

“I renounce every system that opposes the rule of Yah. I come out of Babylon. I withdraw my agreement, my dependence, and my participation. I choose the Kingdom. I choose alignment. I choose obedience.”

After declaring, review the three areas you identified. Begin removing agreement with them through intentional decisions and changes in behavior.

Higher Level Notes (For Advanced Study)

Separation establishes legal distinction in the spirit. What a person remains connected to, they remain accountable to.

Babylon represents more than a physical system. It is a structure of influence that operates through thought patterns, cultural norms, and spiritual compromise.

A disciple must understand that authority flows from alignment. Without separation, there is no clear alignment. Without alignment, there is no authority.

Therefore, separation is not loss. It is the recovery of rightful position.
